



**Skin:** May be mildly irritating to skin.  
**Inhalation:** Not a normal route of exposure.  
**Ingestion:** Corrosive. May cause chemical burns to mouth, throat and stomach.

**EFFECTS OF CHRONIC EXPOSURE:**

**Skin:** Prolonged or repeated exposure to dilutions may cause skin drying in sensitive individuals.  
**Irritancy:** Corrosive to eyes. Mildly irritating to skin.  
**Respiratory Tract Sensitization:** Non-hazardous by OSHA criteria.  
**Carcinogenicity:** Non-hazardous by OSHA criteria.  
**Teratogenicity:** Non-hazardous by OSHA criteria.  
**Mutagenicity:** Non-hazardous by OSHA criteria.  
**Reproductive Effects:** Non-hazardous by OSHA criteria.  
**Synergistic Materials:** None known.

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**SECTION VII - PREVENTATIVE MEASURES**

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**Gloves:** Natural or butyl rubber, nitrile or neoprene gloves.  
**Eye Protection:** Safety goggles or glasses.  
**Respiratory Protection:** Not normally required if good ventilation is maintained and exposure guidelines are not exceeded.  
**Other Protective Equipment:** As required by employer code.  
**Engineering Controls:** General ventilation normally adequate.  
**Leak and Spill Procedure:** Before attempting clean up, refer to hazard data given above. Small spills may be absorbed with non-reactive absorbent and placed in suitable, covered, labelled containers. Prevent large spills from entering sewers or waterways. Contact emergency services and supplier for advice.  
**Waste Disposal:** Review federal, provincial, and local government requirements prior to disposal.  
**Handling Requirements:** Use good industrial hygiene practices in handling this material. When using do not eat or drink. Wash hands before breaks and immediately after handling the product.  
**Storage Requirements:** Keep out of reach of children. Avoid storage at elevated temperatures.

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**SECTION VIII - FIRST AID**

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**Eye:** Flush with cool water. Remove contact lenses, if applicable, and continue flushing. Obtain medical attention immediately.  
**Skin:** Flush with cool water. Wash with soap and water. Obtain medical attention if irritation develops or persists.  
**Inhalation:** Not a normal route of exposure. If symptoms develop move victim to fresh air. If symptoms persist, obtain medical attention.  
**Ingestion:** Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water, then drink one or two glasses of water. Obtain medical attention. Never give anything by mouth if victim is unconscious, or is convulsing.
