



**EFFECTS OF CHRONIC EXPOSURE:**

<b>Skin:</b>	Prolonged or repeated exposure may cause skin drying in sensitive individuals.
<b>Irritancy:</b>	May cause irritation.
<b>Respiratory Tract Sensitization:</b>	Non-hazardous by WHMIS criteria.
<b>Carcinogenicity:</b>	Non-hazardous by WHMIS criteria.
<b>Teratogenicity:</b>	Non-hazardous by WHMIS criteria.
<b>Mutagenicity:</b>	Non-hazardous by WHMIS criteria.
<b>Reproductive Effects:</b>	Non-hazardous by WHMIS criteria.
<b>Synergistic Materials:</b>	None known.

**SECTION VII - PREVENTATIVE MEASURES**

<b>Gloves:</b>	Natural or butyl rubber, nitrile or neoprene gloves.
<b>Eye Protection:</b>	Safety goggles or glasses.
<b>Respiratory Protection:</b>	Not normally required if good ventilation is maintained and exposure guidelines are not exceeded.
<b>Other Protective Equipment:</b>	As required by employer code.
<b>Engineering Controls:</b>	General ventilation normally adequate.
<b>Leak and Spill Procedure:</b>	Before attempting clean up, refer to hazard data given above. Small spills may be absorbed with non-reactive absorbent and placed in suitable, covered, labelled containers. Prevent large spills from entering sewers or waterways. Contact emergency services and supplier for advice.
<b>Waste Disposal:</b>	Review federal, provincial, and local government requirements prior to disposal.
<b>Handling Requirements:</b>	Use good industrial hygiene practices in handling this material. When using do not eat or drink. Wash hands before breaks and immediately after handling the product.
<b>Storage Requirements:</b>	Keep out of reach of children. Avoid storage at elevated temperatures.

<b>Eye:</b>	Flush with cool water. Remove contact lenses, if applicable, and continue flushing. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.
<b>Skin:</b>	Flush with cool water. Wash with soap and water. Obtain medical attention if irritation develops or persists.
<b>Inhalation:</b>	Not a normal route of exposure. If symptoms develop move victim to fresh air. If symptoms persist, obtain medical attention.
<b>Ingestion:</b>	Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water, then drink one or two glasses of water. Obtain medical attention. Never give anything by mouth if victim is unconscious, or is convulsing.
